INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The UnionBank Dollar Bond Portfolio is a US Dollar-denominated bond fund designed to provide investors with higher returns than traditional fixed-income savings products. Earnings volatility is kept at moderate levels, through disciplined investment selection and tenor diversification.

CLIENT SUITABILITY

A client profiling process should be performed prior to participating in the Fund to guide the prospective investor if the Fund is suited to his/her investment objectives and risk tolerance. Clients are advised to read the Declaration of Trust/Plan Rules of the Fund, which may be obtained from the Trustee, before deciding to invest.

- The UnionBank Dollar Bond Portfolio is suitable only for investors who:
 - Are individuals of legal age and corporations with a medium to long-term investment horizon
 - Have a moderately conservative risk profile

Some of the key risks associated with this Fund are listed below:

- **Interest Rate Risk:** This is the possibility to experience losses due to changes in interest rates. The purchase and sale of a debt instrument may result in profit or loss because the value of a debt instrument changes inversely with prevailing interest rates.
- **Market/Price Risk:** This is the possibility to experience losses due to adverse changes in market prices of securities. It is the exposure to the uncertain market value of a portfolio due to price fluctuations.

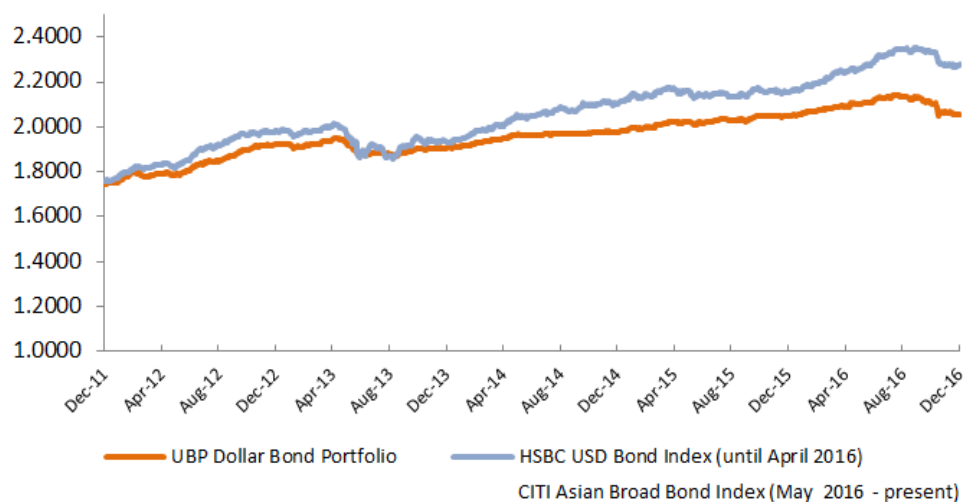

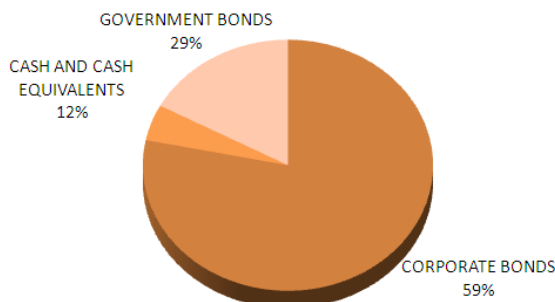
***Information Ratio measures reward-to-risk efficiency of the portfolio relative to the benchmark. The higher the number, the higher the reward per unit of risk.

RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The fund has time deposits with UnionBank of the Philippines amounting to USD 282,653.13. This investment outlet was approved by the Trust Committee. Likewise, all related parties transactions are conducted on an arm's length basis.

OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY

The Federal Reserve unanimously voted to increase the federal funds rate as expected to a range within 0.50-0.75%. This was the first tightening move since it raised rates in December 2015 after keeping rates at near-zero levels following the global financial crisis in 2008.

With FOMC minutes indicating a more dovish tone, market started out strong beginning of the year. The gradual approach to raising rates at the risk of faster economic growth, saw US equities and US Treasuries rally. Rally spilled over to emerging markets especially asian markets. With UST 10 year reaching 2.34%, ROP space saw strong buying momentum across the curve. Liquid ROP's were higher by 3.5 pips while Long dated ROP 41's traded as high 101.50(3.6%) coming off from last quarter's low of 92.50(4.19%) before stabilizing near par levels. We expect more volatility especially before the inauguration of President elect Donald Trump as all eyes are on the implementation of rhetoric policy campaign.
