INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The UnionBank Dollar Bond Portfolio is a US Dollar-denominated bond fund designed to provide investors with higher returns than traditional fixed-income savings products. Earnings volatility is kept at moderate levels, through disciplined investment selection and tenor diversification.

CLIENT SUITABILITY

A client profiling process should be performed prior to participating in the Fund to guide the prospective investor if the Fund is suited to his/her investment objectives and risk tolerance. Some of the key risks associated with this Fund are listed below:

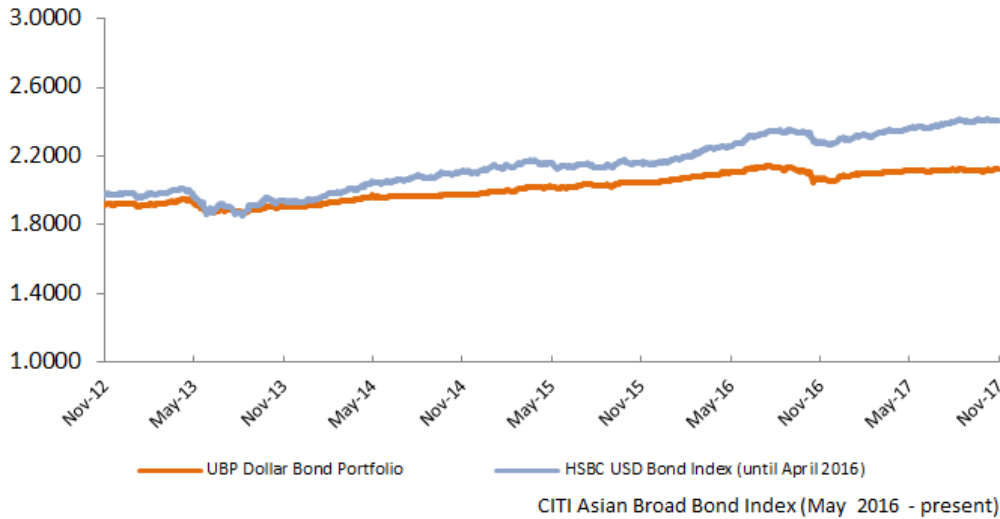

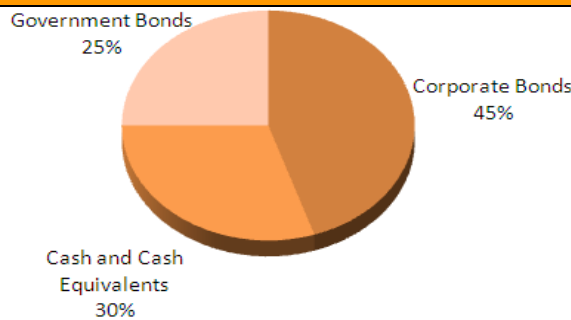

RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The fund has time deposits with UnionBank of the Philippines amounting to USD 1.10 Mn. This investment outlet was approved by the Trust Committee. Likewise, all related parties transactions are conducted on an arm's length basis.

OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY

Latest FOMC minutes came out relatively dovish with some policy makers expressing concerns on low inflation expectations and some emphasis that additional tightening would depend will still remain data dependent. Meanwhile economic data were mixed but were fairly upbeat. US 3rd Qtr GDP growth was revised upward to 3.3%. Jobless claims remained low while personal consumption expenditures rose 0.3% in October easing from 0.9% in September. Market is now focused on the US senators version of the Tax reform.

UST yields were volatile for the month of October with swings for the 10yr UST benchmark of almost 10 basis point range. The yield curve steepened with corporate debt supply concerns as the long end experienced upward pressure while short end of the curve remained relatively unchanged. ROP price movement was relatively subdued and was able to recover from losses from the first three weeks of the month. After dropping to 99(3.76%), liquid long end bond ROP 42's was able to recover to 99.70(3.72%). We may see further defensive trading as market players remain cautious ahead of the December FED rate hike.
